The Bro Tudno (Llandudno) Ministry Area consists of the Great Orme and the part of the town of Llandudno, north and west of the railway line/Vaughan Street. See www.brotudno.org.uk/about/

The term “ministry area” below refers to both Bro Tudno and the former Parish of Llandudno which includes Holy Trinity Church, St. Tudno’s Church and the former churches of St. George and Our Saviour.

The Vicar is under a legal duty to be satisfied that you can lawfully marry in the ministry area before the marriage can take place, or a firm date and time can be fixed for it.

One of the applicants must live within the ministry area, or be on the electoral roll. Alternatively, one of the applicants must have a Qualifying Connection with the ministry area.

Just one of the applicants should complete the following form.

If you claim to have a Qualifying Connection, then you will need to complete another form giving details of the qualification. This form will be emailed to you.
