## Wormhout Memorial Appeal

To mark the 85<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the infamous Wormhout Massacre of 28 May 1940, help us to create a new stained-glass window dedicated to the soldiers who lost their lives at the time of this atrocity on the retreat to Dunkirk. Included were eight men from Llandudno: gunners of the 69<sup>th</sup> Medium Regiment Royal Artillery.

Other known units involved in this atrocity were the 2<sup>nd</sup> Royal Warwickshire Regiment, the 4<sup>th</sup> Cheshire Regiment, the 53<sup>rd</sup> (Worcestershire Yeomanry) Royal Artillery, and the 8<sup>th</sup> Worcestershire Regiment.

A French soldier was also murdered that day.

The new window will be placed in Holy Trinity's Memorial Chapel which celebrated its 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary in 2024. It will feature an image of St. Winnoc, a 7<sup>th</sup> Century Abbot of Flanders and Patron Saint of Wormhout.
